

SCNV Sportsmanship Awards

May 2014 – April 2015

SCNV is introducing two new trophies for the 2014-2015 season, both of which will be awarded to skaters who demonstrate the best Sportsmanship. Sportsmanship is defined as “fair play, respect for opponents, and polite behavior by someone who is competing in a sport or other competition.” In order to be eligible, a skater must be an SCNV member and have competed in at least one U.S. Figure Skating competition during the past season. The “Be Nice on the Ice” trophy will be awarded to a non-qualifying level skater, and the “Sportsmanship” trophy will be awarded to a qualifying-level skater. Fairfax Ice Arena coaches who are U.S. Figure Skating category A or B compliant may nominate up to three skaters for each trophy, and the coaches then vote to choose the winners.
