



Blue Ridge Classic | COVID-19 Code of Conduct October 23-24, 2021

All registered skaters, coaches, volunteers, officials, vendors and spectators who wish to participate in the 2021 Blue Ridge Classic competition agree to adhere to this COVID-19 Code of Conduct as a condition to their participation. Parents are responsible that accompanying minor children attending as spectators also adhere to this COVID-19 Code of Conduct, and parents will sign the Code of Conduct on their behalf. This form must be signed and submitted to the Blue Ridge Classic LOC in order to receive credentials or spectator passes necessary to access competitor areas and spectator seating on the ice surface where the competition will be held.

At all times during the competition, I pledge to:

- Stay home if I am sick and/or running a temperature higher than 100.4 degrees.
- Accurately report any symptoms of illness at the registration desk and truthfully answer all screening questions.
- Truthfully report any close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of the competition.
- Be subject to a medical evaluation and obtain medical clearance in the event I answer yes to having any symptoms of COVID-19 or answer yes to any of the screening questions.
- Maintain social distancing whenever possible, except within family groups.
- Wear a face mask at all times while inside Ion International Training Center.
 - Skaters who are currently competing may remove their mask prior to the start of their program and must put it back on after completing their program, before returning to their seat.
 - Face masks must be worn over the nose and mouth, and under the chin.
 - Face masks should be made of tightly woven fabric, ideally with multiple layers, or surgical masks. Handkerchiefs and gaiters do not qualify as masks.
- Follow the designated traffic patterns in Ion International Training Center.
- Withdraw from the Blue Ridge Classic if I am diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of the competition.

I agree that if I do not sign this Code of Conduct, I will not be provided with a credential or spectator pass to enter the Ion International Training Center to participate in or view the 2021 Blue Ridge Classic. Further, if I do not follow the Code of Conduct while participating in the Blue Ridge Classic, I understand that my credential or spectator pass will be revoked.
